# Parent Consultations

# <u>Attendance</u>

There is a dramatic increase in the number of parents taking children out of school during term time. Many of these are unauthorised absences. Please be aware that any planned leave of absence during term time needs to be requested at least two weeks in advance by completing the Leave Of Absence form available outside of the school office. Leave can only be authorised for exceptional circumstances. Please note family holidays are not classified as exceptional circumstance. Persistent absenteeism is regarded as less than 95% attendance. You should be aware that failure to secure your child's regular attendance at school can amount to offence contrary to S444 (1) of the Education Act 1996. In accordance with current guidance, unauthorised is capable of triggering a referral to the Local Authority Education Welfare Team for a Fixed Penalty Notice.


