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Parent Governor

We are keen to welcome a new parent governor onto our Governing body. This is an exciting opportunity to find out how school runs in all its detail and how Government directives and initiatives are developed in school. We feel that Parent Governors are essential on our Governing Body as they provide the natural channels for Parents to talk directly to Governors, to discuss the curriculum, financing and any issues arising. We value our Parent Governors highly and are really excited that we have a vacancy available.

Parent Governors must be elected by the parents of pupils at the school and must themselves have children at the school. The normal period of office is four years. A Parent Governor is not obliged to resign from office if his/her child leaves the school and may remain on the Governing Body until his/her period of office expires. This is a significant commitment as Governors are expected to volunteer their time to attend meetings, carry out monitoring activities as well as undertake training. A good level of attendance is essential to carry out their legal responsibilities.

I will be available to advise any parent who is interested in the possibility of standing for election, on the style and work of the Governing Body and meeting times. If more nominations are received than are required to fill the vacancy, prospective candidates will be given the opportunity of providing me with a brief election address, which I will arrange to have circulated with the ballot papers. Any parent who wishes to stand for election should return the nomination form attached, duly completed, no later than 8th July 2016.

May I remind you that children break up for the summer holidays on Tuesday 19th July at 3pm and start back at school on WEDNESDAY 7th September 2016. On behalf of the staff and myself, may we wish you a happy summer holiday and we look forward to seeing you in the next academic year.
