Safeguarding and independence

Now that our children are settled into the school routine, we would like to encourage our children to become as independent as possible when coming into school. Consultation

The Council's Cabinet met to consider the outcomes of the consultations carried out in relation to school structure in the Alnwick Partnership and to decide whether or not to publish statutory proposals in relation to the 10 community schools in the Alnwick Partnership. For your information, the Cabinet have decided to approve the publication of statutory proposals in relation to the 10 community schools and these were published on Thursday 12 November opening a 4 week period of statutory consultation when representations for or against the proposals can be submitted. These include proposals to close Seahouses, Alnwick the Duke's and Alnwick Lindisfarne Middle Schools with effect from 31 August 2017, to extend the age ranges of Swarland, Branton, Shilbottle, Hipsburn, Swansfield Park and Seahouses First Schools from September 2016 and to extend the age range of The Duchess's Community High School from September 2017. At the same time, St Paul's Catholic Schools Federation will be publishing a statutory proposal to close St Paul's Middle School with effect from 31 August 2017.
